TEAM CAMPS

June 4th-7th, 2017 (1st Division Camp June 4-5 / Second Division Camp June 6-7)

- This camp consists of 16 high school varsity and 8 JV teams competing at a high-scale competition level in the 1st division camp June 4-5 and a medium-scale competition in the 2nd division camp June 6-7. Cost \$425 per team (\$50 Discount per team if school brings Varsity & JV to make it \$375)
- Camp gives your teams the opportunity to play schools you may not see during the school year and allows college coaches to observe and watch all your players.
- Camp consists of a minimum of 6 games and provides great competition and atmosphere for your players. (CHAMPION TEAMS AWARDED T-SHIRTS)

ELITE HIGH SCHOOL CAMP

June 24th & 25th, 2017

- Players will be divided into small workout groups according to their individual position and will receive 10 hours of specialized instruction. Players and coaches from CSU-Pueblo's 2016-17 RMAC Championship team will instruct. The camp will also include competitive games and contests in which players can showcase their talents and practice their new skills.

This is designed to be an elite camp so numbers will be kept small in order to maximize individual attention from the CSU-Pueblo Coaching Staff. Numbers will be limited to 48 total (30 guards, 18 post players) so please register early!

CAMP DIRECTORS

CURTIS LOYD - Camp Director



Curtis Loyd became the 10th head women's basketball coach in school history. Building on previous success is nothing new for Loyd. He comes to the Pack from Louisiana State University Shreveport of the NAIA where he led the Pilots to a 22-10 record and a program-record 15 conference wins.

Loyd guided the Pilots to their first Red River Athletic Conference Tournament Championship. For his efforts, Loyd was recognized as RRAC Coach of the Year in his only season behind the bench for the Pilots. In just one season in Shreveport, Loyd mentored three student-athletes to First Team All-RRAC, including RRAC Player of the Year Kourtney Pennywell.

For 20 years prior to his time with the Pilots, Loyd served as an assistant women's basketball coach at the NCAA D-I level. His most recent experience came at Indiana University where he helped the Hoosiers to a 36-28 record over two seasons. In his second year with the Hoosiers, Loyd helped them to an NCAA Tournament appearance and first round victory over University of Georgia.

Before joining the Hoosiers, Loyd spent four seasons as the Associate Head Basketball Coach at the Big Ten's University of Minnesota. In four seasons, he took the Golden Gophers from a 13-win team to a 22-win team. Loyd helped recruit All-Americans Rachel Banham and Amanda Zahui to Minnesota.

In one season with University of Akron, Loyd helped the Zips to a seven-win increase, taking an 11-19 team to 18-14. As Associate Head Basketball Coach he was a key contributor to 2010 MAC Coach of the Year Jodi Kest.

As he worked his way up the D-I coaching ladder, Loyd made stops at the University of Virginia, University of Arizona, and Colorado State University. He was an Assistant Coach at all three destinations.

During this time, Loyd worked with five All-Americans, 22 all-conference athletes. His teams went a combined 291-122 (.705). With the Rams, Loyd guided WNBA legend, and current San Antonio Spurs Assistant Coach Becky Hammon to All-American honors and a school points record that has not been approached since.
